1. **Booking fee, Contract, and Registration Papers.** An Inclusive \$300.00 non-refundable booking fee must be paid to Bent Jensen when mare owner returns contract. A copy of the mare's registration papers must be submitted with the contract if the mare is to be included in any report of mares bred to Cassidy.
2. **Documentation.** When this contract is signed and returned, a duplicate copy will be signed and returned to mare owner. The Mare Breeding Form will be provided to the mare owner and must be filled out by the mare owner and attending veterinarian and returned to Jeannette Bair, breeding manager. Confirmation of whether the mare is or is not in foal must be provided to Jeannette Bair once mare owner has been provided confirmation. A delivery and Insemination Certificate for Transported Semen will be sent with each shipment of semen. The certificate must be completed by the veterinarian on each day of insemination. Collection will be made at the breeding farm or at the veterinarian clinic and will be shipped Federal Express or can be picked up at collection location. The mare owner must return the semen container , with the completed Deliver and Insemination Certificate by Federal Express 2

day service within 24 hours of receipt of the transported semen. This semen container will be returned to the breeding farm or clinic (address and phone number will be provided).

3. **Pre-shipment Steps.** In addition to the signed contract and the booking fee and the mare form, the breeding farm must receive a \$300 deposit on the Equitainer, and a current uterine culture before live semen will be shipped to the mare owner. The Equitaners deposit shall be returned when all breeding is complete and all Equitaners have been returned. Mare owner will be charged shipping fees at cost. Mare owner must send to Jeannette Bair the balance due on the breeding fee, check made out to Bent Jensen, before shipment of semen will be made.
4. **Shipment.** The mare owner will be charged a \$150 collection fee per collection or the fee as identified at the clinic where collection may occur.
5. **Mare Specific.** The transported semen may be used for only the mare designated on this contract, and all excess semen must be destroyed. Should the semen be used on a mare other than the mare so designated on this contract without Bent Jensen's written permission, this contract becomes null and void. Should the mare be sold during contract term, the contract will only transfer to the new owner of the mare if agreed to in writing by Bent Jensen or Jeannette Bair.
6. **Live Foal Guarantee:** It is agreed that a live foal (i.e. a newborn foal that stands and nurses) is guaranteed from the transported semen for a maximum of three breeding seasons. A new booking fee of \$300.00 will be paid for each successive year. The mare owner may exercise return privileges for the following season, if Bent Jensen or Jeannette Bair is notified within 72 hours from the foaling date and receives a veterinarian's statement concerning the circumstances of death within 10 days of the foaling date. If the mare dies or, after examination by two licensed veterinarians, is found unfit to breed, another mare may be substituted with the consent of Bent Jensen or Jeannette Bair. If the mare is examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be barren 50 to 70 days from the date of insemination, return privileges will also be granted. If, after two full breeding seasons the mare does not conceive, the mare owner may substitute another mare with the consent of Bent Jensen or Jeannette Bair.
7. **In the Case of Stallion death.** In case of stallion death or loss of use for breeding purposes, Bent Jensen reserves the right to offer a substitute stallion (s) to mare owner.
8. **Maintaining Guarantee.** A licensed veterinarian must examine the mare 50 to 70 days after the last insemination date and advise Jeannette Bair in writing of the mare's pregnancy status. If this notification is not provided, the live foal guarantee of this contract becomes null and void. This notification can be provided by returning the completed Mare Breeding Form.
9. **Semen Administration.** The breeding farm will assume responsibility only to deliver live semen in viable condition at the time of delivery to the mare owner or his or her designee. The semen must be administered by a licensed

veterinarian on the day of delivery; otherwise, all conditions of this contract become null and void.

- 10. **Contract execution.** This contract is in duplicate. The mare owner must sign both copies and return them to Jeannette Bair. When Ms. Bair signs and returns one copy of this contract to the mare owner, it will then be a binding contract on both parties, subject to all above terms and conditions. This contract may not be assigned or transferred by mare owner.
- 11. The breeding season is from April 1 to June 30th at minimum and will be extended at Bent Jensen or Jeannette Bair's discretion once agreement has been made between each party.
